## **Settling Back into School**

Our team has been especially focused on helping Year 7 students settle into secondary school, as well as supporting students who have significant additional needs. Please be assured that our teachers use adaptive strategies in every lesson and go above and beyond to support students in their learning. These have been refreshed for the new school year, and your child's voice has been central to this. Ms Kaur has already met with most of our students to gather their thoughts on how we can best support them in school.
