Dear Parents/Carers and Students of Our Arena,

As many of you are aware, there are incidences of knife crime happening in the area. We are in constant communication with West Midlands Police who have been proactive in delivering assemblies warning of the danger of knife crime. However, it is our collective responsibility to ensure the safety and welfare of everyone on site, so can the following please continue to happen:

All students must not carry any weapon, of any type, at any time. Parents must continue to have conversations with their child regarding the danger of carrying knives and periodically check bags. If any student hears that a student may be carrying a knife, they must inform a member of staff - this can be done confidentiality using Whisper too: Whisper - Report a Concern - Arena Academy. Staff will continue to discuss this issue with students, and periodically random bag searches will be carried out. We must continue to work together to keep everyone safe.
