Good attendance is one of the most important factors in a child's success—academically, socially, and emotionally (a student with 95% or above attendance is twice as likely to achieve at least a grade 5 in English and Maths: Insights
Update: Understanding Attendance). When students attend regularly, they:

- Keep up with the curriculum and avoid falling behind.
- Build strong relationships with peers and staff.
- Develop routines and habits that support lifelong learning.
- Feel more confident and engaged in school life.

Year 11 Mock Examinations

I am delighted that these have got off to a good start last week, with the practical examinations of Art, Music, Drama and Food taking place. They will be done in line with their GCSEs next summer, there will not be an opportunity for a student to resit their exam if it is missed. I highly recommend all students to attend these booster sessions – breakfast will also be available.
