As you may have heard in the news, the use of mobile phones in school is prohibited. At Arena Academy, our policy is: if a phone is seen or heard it will be confiscated and only a Parent/Carer will be required to collect it. We appreciate this may cause some inconvenience for parents initially, but hopefully students will get the message to keep their phone switched off and in their bag. It will not be returned to the student. We understand the need for phones to be with a student to and from school, but there is no need for them to be used during a school day. Vaping

The number of children using vapes has tripled in the last three years and there is strong evidence to suggest that cheap and easy-to-use disposable vapes are partly to blame. The Department for Health and Social Care announced last week that disposable vapes will be banned in the UK as part of government plans to tackle the rise in youth vaping and protect children's health. If a child at Arena Academy is seen with a vape, they will be suspended and then placed on a mandatory 'dangers of vaping' course.
