Headteacher Bulletin 9th June 2025

Dear Parents/Carers and Students of Our Arena,

Over the next few weeks, we will be trialling a few initiatives that we will be implementing across the school from September and would welcome feedback from parents and students as to their views.

Equipment Mats

At Our Arena, we want to ensure that our learners are always ready, respectful and safe. As part of our Teaching and Learning toolkit, we expect students to arrive at school ready to participate in learning within the classroom.

Within their toolkit, we expect students to have the following equipment:

- Pencil case
- Black or Blue writing pen
- Red pen
- Mini Whiteboard Pen
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Eraser
- Pencil Sharpener

Form Tutors will be checking student equipment every morning as part of Our Arena Norms to be sure that they are ready for the day. To do this, each student will place their toolkit equipment on the learning mat on their desk during morning Form Time. The Form tutor will check everything is correct and will record on Class charts if there is missing equipment. From Monday 9th June, students will receive a 30-minute reflection if they are missing a piece of equipment. Students are able to purchase the equipment from any local shop or retailer or can use CORE Points within school to purchase a single item or a filled pencil case.

Free Breakfast for all

There is much research outlining that students who eat breakfast are more prepared for their learning for the day. We have trialled providing breakfast for all Year 7 students in their form room during this week. Feedback from students and staff was very positive. Other year groups are able to obtain their free breakfast from the canteen as normal. We plan to roll out all students having breakfast during form time from September.

Mobile phones - See it, Hear it, Lose it

A reminder that all students should not be using a mobile phone during the school day. They should be switched off when arriving at school, placed in their bag and not switched on again until they leave. Parents can support this by not phoning their child during the school day. If any parent needs to contact their child, they should use the main school phone number, and we will get a message to them.

Year 7 Parents Evening - Thursday 19th June

A reminder to Parents of Year 7 students that the Parents Evening will take place on Thursday 17^{th} June from 4:00-7:00pm. There are no appointments, parents are invited to attend at any time. This is an opportunity to meet the teachers of your child to discuss their progress and ask any questions you may have.
