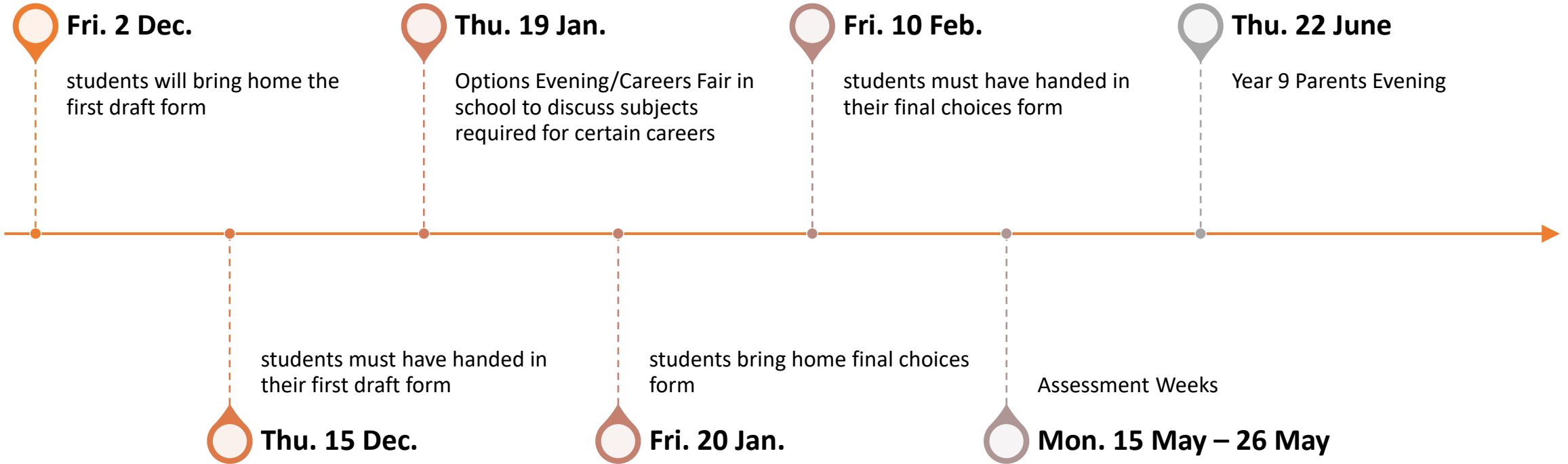

Frequently asked questions

Question: Does triple science mean you do one less option?

Answer: No – all science is taught in the 5 periods of science

Question: Can I choose both History and Geography?
